1. Human Sexuality	How people express themselves and their sexual preferences.	14. Annulment	The ending of a marriage, declaring that the original marriage was never valid.
2. Heterosexual	A person who is attracted to the opposite gender.	15. Family	A group of people who are related by blood, marriage, or adoption.
3. Homosexual	A person who is attracted to the same gender.	16. Nuclear Family	A couple and their children.
4. Sex before marriage	Sex between two unmarried people.	17. Polygamy	A person having more than one wife.
5. Sex outside of marriage	Commonly known as cheating, adultery, or having an affair, this is where one person is married and having sex with someone who is not their partner.	18. Bigamy	The illegal practice of being married to more than one person in the UK.
6. Contraception	A method used to prevent sex from leading to pregnancy.	19. Procreation	Having children.
7. Family Planning	Methods used to try and control or decide when a couple will have a child.	20. Stability	Providing a person with safety and security, instead of rapid changes or disruptions.
8. Marriage	A legal union between two people, declaring them partners in a relationship.	21. Protection of children	Keeping children safe from harm.
9. Civil Partnership	A union that was sometimes reserved for same sex couples.	22. Educating children in the faith	Some religious believers may see a purpose of family is to educate children within their religious community.
10. Same-sex marriage	Marriage between two people of the same gender.	23. Gender Equality	Giving individuals the same rights regardless of their gender.
11. Cohabitation	Living with a romantic partner without being married.	24. Gender Prejudice	Judging a person before knowing them or their abilities based on their gender,
12. Divorce	The legal ending of a marriage.	25. Complementarian	The belief that men and women should fulfil different roles in society because of their gender.
13. Remarriage	Marrying again after being divorced.	26. Gender Discrimination	Acting differently towards a person based on their gender. This is illegal in the UK.
