<b>1. Human Sexuality</b>	How people express themselves and their sexual preferences.	<b>14. Annulment</b>	The ending of a marriage, declaring that the original marriage was never valid.
<b>2. Heterosexual</b>	A person who is attracted to the opposite gender.	<b>15. Family</b>	A group of people who are related by blood, marriage, or adoption.
<b>3. Homosexual</b>	A person who is attracted to the same gender.	<b>16. Nuclear Family</b>	A couple and their children.
<b>4. Sex before marriage</b>	Sex between two unmarried people.	<b>17. Polygamy</b>	A person having more than one wife.
<b>5. Sex outside of marriage</b>	Commonly known as cheating, adultery, or having an affair, this is where one person is married and having sex with someone who is not their partner.	<b>18. Bigamy</b>	The illegal practice of being married to more than one person in the UK.
<b>6. Contraception</b>	A method used to prevent sex from leading to pregnancy.	<b>19. Procreation</b>	Having children.
<b>7. Family Planning</b>	Methods used to try and control or decide when a couple will have a child.	<b>20. Stability</b>	Providing a person with safety and security, instead of rapid changes or disruptions.
<b>8. Marriage</b>	A legal union between two people, declaring them partners in a relationship.	<b>21. Protection of children</b>	Keeping children safe from harm.
<b>9. Civil Partnership</b>	A union that was sometimes reserved for same sex couples.	<b>22. Educating children in the faith</b>	Some religious believers may see a purpose of family is to educate children within their religious community.
<b>10. Same-sex marriage</b>	Marriage between two people of the same gender.	<b>23. Gender Equality</b>	Giving individuals the same rights regardless of their gender.
<b>11. Cohabitation</b>	Living with a romantic partner without being married.	<b>24. Gender Prejudice</b>	Judging a person before knowing them or their abilities based on their gender,
<b>12. Divorce</b>	The legal ending of a marriage.	<b>25. Complementarian</b>	The belief that men and women should fulfil different roles in society because of their gender..
<b>13. Remarriage</b>	Marrying again after being divorced.	<b>26. Gender Discrimination</b>	Acting differently towards a person based on their gender. This is illegal in the UK.
