1. Universe	All of time and space consisting of all the stars and planets.	14. Cosmetic Testing	Testing on animals for products like makeup to check that they are safe for humans.
2. Big Bang	A massive expansion of space that created the universe.	15. Medical Testing	Testing on animals to make sure that medicine is safe for humans.
3. Literalist Christians	A group that interprets the Bible literally, and believes in the Genesis creation story word for word.	16. Vegetarian	Not eating animals or meat.
4. Liberal Christians	A group of Christians that see the Genesis story as a metaphor to describe the creation of the universe.	17. Halal	Food which is acceptable for Muslims. Animals have to be killed in a certain way in order to be halal.
5. Awe and wonder	The idea that humans look at the universe and are impressed by its complexity.	18. Sanctity of Life	The idea that all life is special (sacred) and so cannot be taken by humans.
6. Responsibility	A duty of care for something or someone	19. Quality of Life	The idea that a person should enjoy their life, or be free from excessive suffering.
7. Stewardship	The idea that humans should look after the world on behalf of God.	20. Abortion	The ending (termination) of a pregnancy.
8. Dominion	The have control over something.	21. Ensoulment	The idea that a human receives a soul during pregnancy.
9. Khalifah	The Islamic belief in stewardship.	22. Euthanasia	A “good death” in Greek, this term means ending a person's life before it would naturally end to prevent suffering,
10. Pollution	Making something dirty or contaminated, especially the environment.	23. Active Euthanasia	This involved giving the person something (e.g. a drug) that would end the person's life.
11. Natural resources	Materials found in nature, such as oil and trees.	24. Passive Euthanasia	This involves withdrawing medical support, and allowing the person to die naturally.
12. Non-renewable resources	Resources that we can use but there are only a limited amount of them.	25. Pro Life	A group that says that women should be allowed to choose to have an abortion.
13. Environment	The natural world, the surroundings in which something lives.	26. Pro Choice	A group that says that the right to life of the foetus is the most important, and that abortion should not be allowed.
