Students should arrive in full school uniform, with equipment ready to learn. Students should arrive at the Sports Hall at their allocated time regardless of whether they have given permission for testing. Students to be tested will remain in the Sports Hall whilst any without permission will go straight to their Form Tutor.

If, due to transport issues, your child needs to arrive at the normal start time they may do so and proceed straight to their form room to await their testing slot.

The timetable has been suspended for the first day of term.

There will be virtual lessons via Google Classroom for students to attend prior to their testing time slot. Access through google classroom for your form through the school website. When in school students will join their form group for a range of activities to prepare for the year ahead.

Normal timetables will begin on Tuesday 11th January.

We will be maintaining sensible precautions to reduce the risk of Covid infections.
