
We would also like to take this opportunity to ask for the support of parents/carers that transport their children to Shirebrook Academy by vehicle. We have received reports from colleagues in Stubbin Wood that the designated yellow disabled parking bays at the front of the car park have been used by non-blue badge holders and this has impacted upon the ability of some parents/carers to get their children, with mobility needs, to school safely. Please ensure that unless you are a blue badge holder, you do not park in the designated disabled bays.

There are difficulties with parking at peak times but we would like to ask for your support in ensuring that when the shared car park is accessed, thought is given to the safe transit of children and adults. Walkways should not be accessed by vehicles and it is important that the bus bays and pedestrian crossings are not obstructed. We do have the collection and drop off point that can be accessed safely at the rear of the car park and this should be used where possible.
