We had so many individual performances with children receiving a medal if they came 1st or 2nd in any of the events. #### **LVSSA Secondary District Athletics Championships**





On Thursday over 80 Simon Balle students from Year 7-12 competed at the District Athletics Championships at Wodson Park. There were so many excellent performances yesterday with so many students achieving top 3 finishes. However the overall Female District performance of the day went to Emily W (Y7) who equalled the Minor Hurdles record finishing first in 11.8 secs. Alex G (Y12) was awarded Simon Balle athlete of the day, as he won the Senior boys 200m, finished second in the Long Jump and anchored the relay team to first place.
