Shoes

- Students must wear plain black, fitted polishable shoes (no canvas shoes, no boots, or no shoes with sports logos are permitted) – appropriate trainers are only permitted with a medical certificate and all other students will wear school-issued plimsolls if they attend school in trainers.

PE Kit

- White and black polo shirt with thin green piping
- Reversible green/black rugby shirt
- Black shorts or skorts

Bags

- Students should use backpacks for school. We advise students **do not** to use the following style:



Coats

- Outdoor coats must be plain coloured fabric – no hoodies, no denim, no leather, no large fur hoods and no logos larger than a credit card.

The following styles are NOT permitted:



General

- Skirts should be worn at a length appropriate for school. Persistently failing to do so may result in a consequence.
- Make up and nail varnish should not be visible and fake eyelashes must not be worn. Students will be given appropriate material to remove if worn. No artificial nails are allowed.
- Only one pair of plain stud earrings are permitted. Rings, necklaces and bracelets should not be worn unless it is a medical bracelet. No facial piercings are allowed. Jewellery will be confiscated for five days if worn.
- No white socks are to be worn with trousers.
- Hair colour must be a natural shade.
- No mobile phones nor headphones are permitted during the school day. Phones can be confiscated for up to five days.
