For example: If you wish to study BTEC Sport as a double award, worth 2 A levels, please select BTEC Sport (Single) in C and BTEC Sport (Double) in E plus one other A level from blocks B or D.

This is the same for the CTEC Business (Single) and (Double) option.



CALCULATING YOUR AVERAGE POINT SCORE

For Simon Balle's entry requirement score, your **Average Point Score (APS)** is calculated by using your best 8 grades at GCSE.

Each grade is worth the number of points shown in the table.

Add the 8 grades together and divide by 8


