# Timescales

- IF you are on your bronze award you will need to do the following
  - Physical - 3 months
  - Skill - 3 months
  - Volunteering 3 months
  - **One of these will need to be 6 months.**
  
- If you are doing silver award you will need to do the following
  - Physical - 3 or 6 months
  - Skill - 3 or 6 months
  - Volunteering - 6 months
  - **If you didn't do Bronze, you must undertake a further 6 months in either the Volunteering or the longer of the Physical or Skills sections.**
