<u>Timescales</u>



- IF you are on your bronze award you will need to do the following
 - Physical 3 months
 - Skill 3 months
 - Volunteering 3 months
 - One of these will need to be 6 months.

- If you are doing silver award you will need to do the following
 - Physical 3 or 6 months
 - Skill 3 or 6 months
 - Volunteering 6 months
 - If you didn't do Bronze, you must undertake a further 6 months in either the Volunteering or the longer of the Physical or Skills sections.

<u>Uploading Evidence</u>



For each of your sections you will be required to upload regular evidence. This has to be done on E D of E.

It is best if you update your evidence on a weekly basis so that you can stay on top of it.
