Dear Parent/Carer,

In response to yesterday's government announcement that in the week beginning Monday 4 January 2021, school will be open only to vulnerable children, children of key workers and pupils in exam year groups Years 11 and 13.

We understand that Years 8, 9 10 & 12 already have experience of accessing the on-site curriculum as previously provided and should continue to access their on-line learning as normal.

For Year 7 students this is the first time students will have access to this method of study from home and we understand this will be a change from their normal way of working. However, support will be available on the school website for guidance.

As the school will be open for vulnerable and key workers students, please would you communicate to us verification of your key worker status on the online form on the school website on the top banner. We ask the key worker form should be completed by no later than noon on Tuesday 22 December 2020.

For students eligible for Free School Meals and not attending school, parents will be issued with a £15 supermarket voucher during the week commencing 4 January 2021.

We are working to an incredibly tight timescale to achieve this provision and we would ask all parents to show patience and understanding in this extremely challenging situation.

Please take comfort in the reassuring words provided by Joe Maggs, S. Peter's Chaplaincy team.
