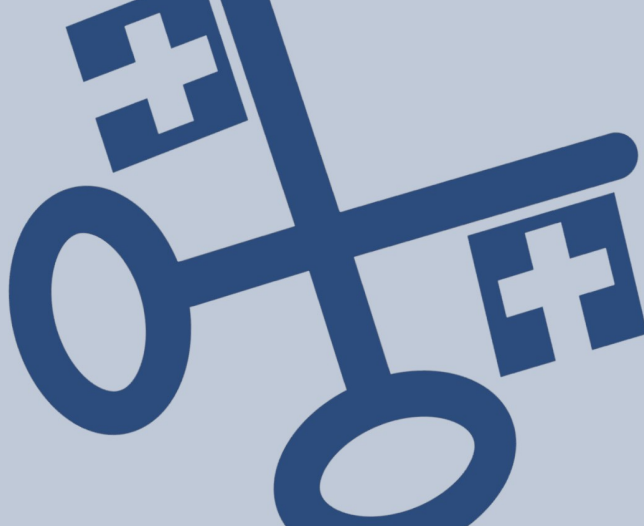

Plain navy blue or plain black coat

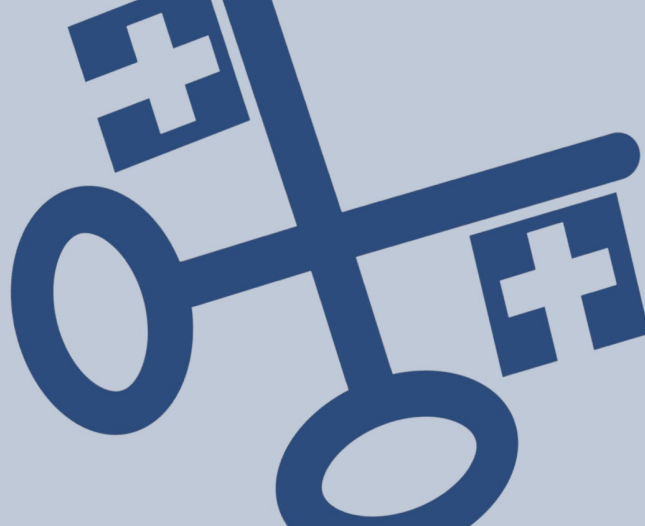
Scarf - Plain navy blue or black school scarf.

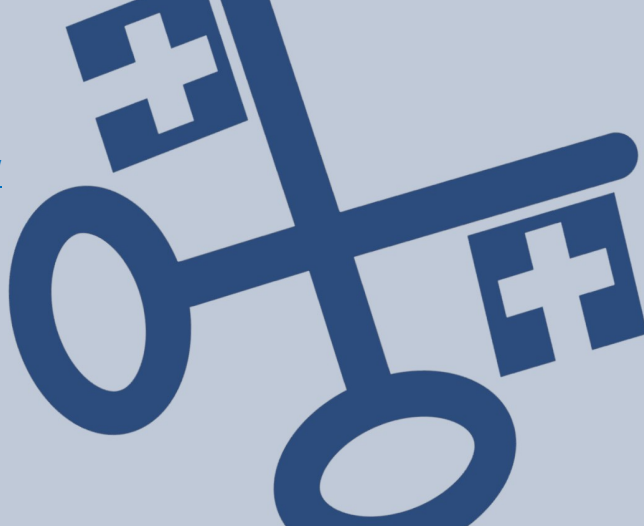

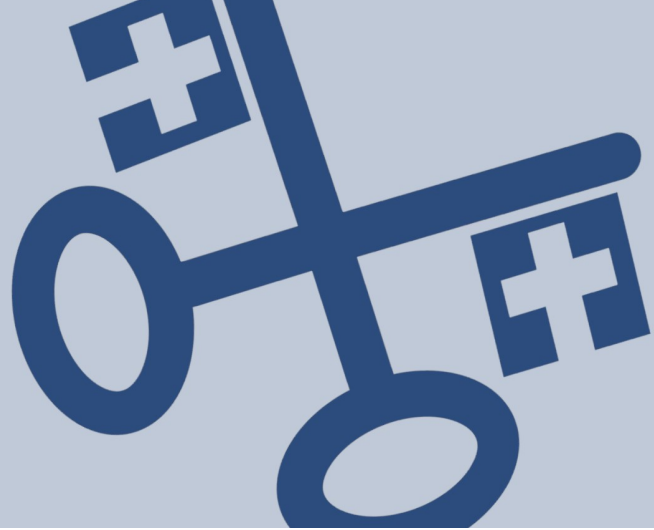

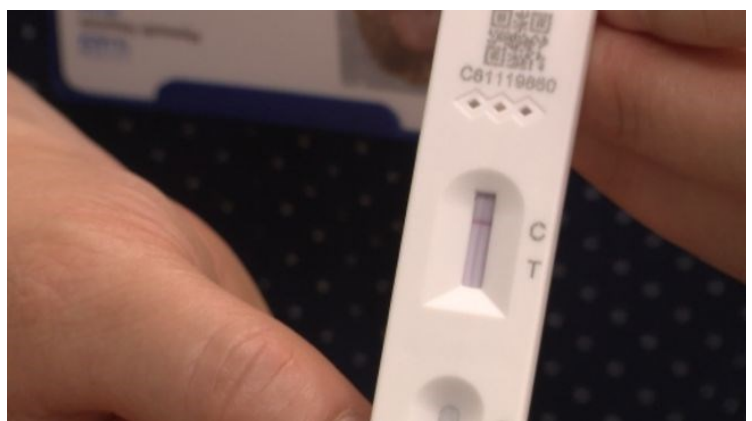
Class Charts

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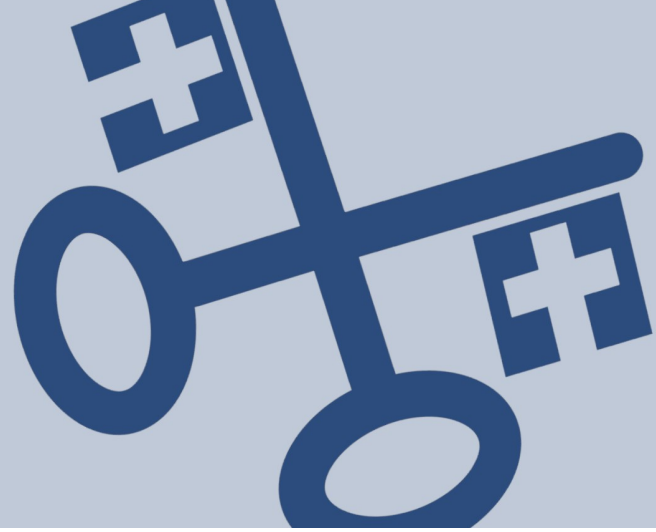
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GOVERNMENT LAPTOP LOANS

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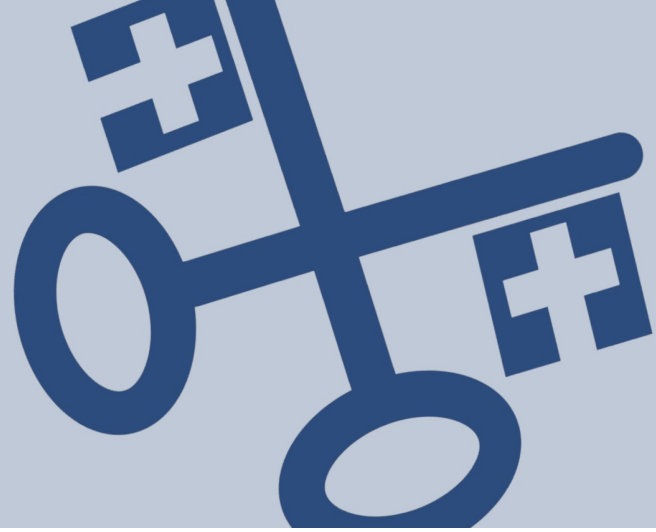

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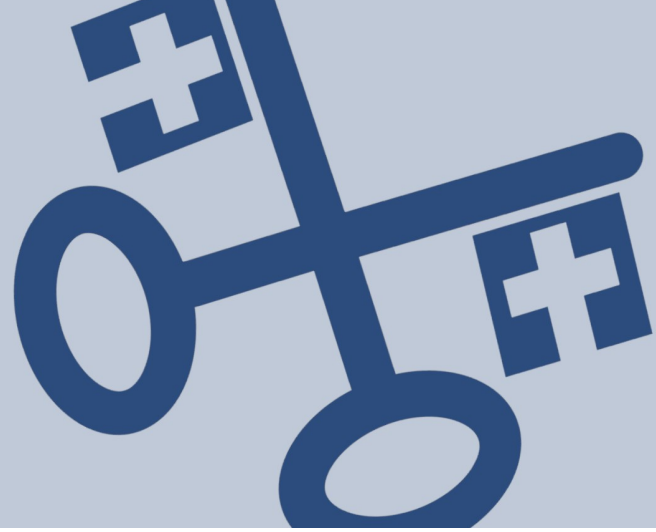
