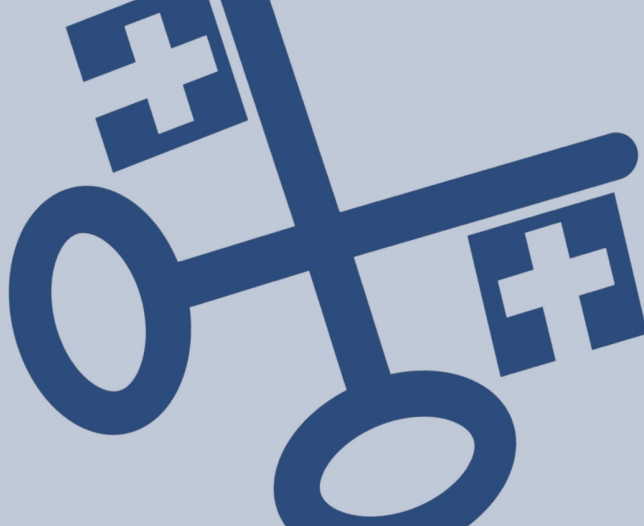
We are currently working on our Worship for the last day of term and it has been interesting to try and link the theme of supporting a team with how God supports us all, as one of our main themes.

Plain navy blue or plain black coat

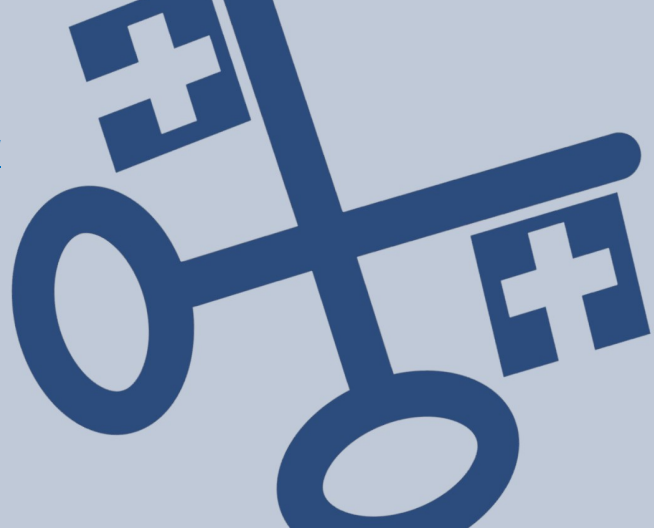
Scarf - Plain navy blue or black school scarf.

Front or side vent skirt.

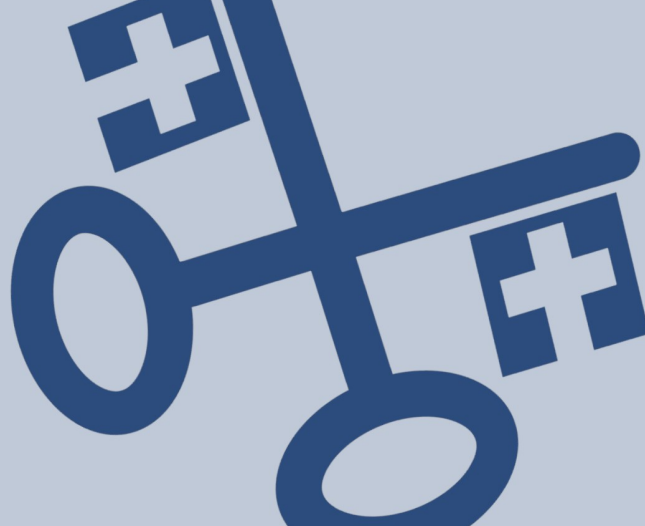

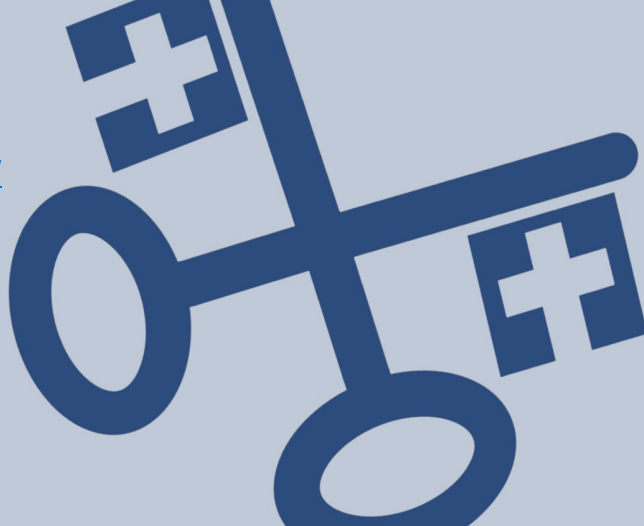

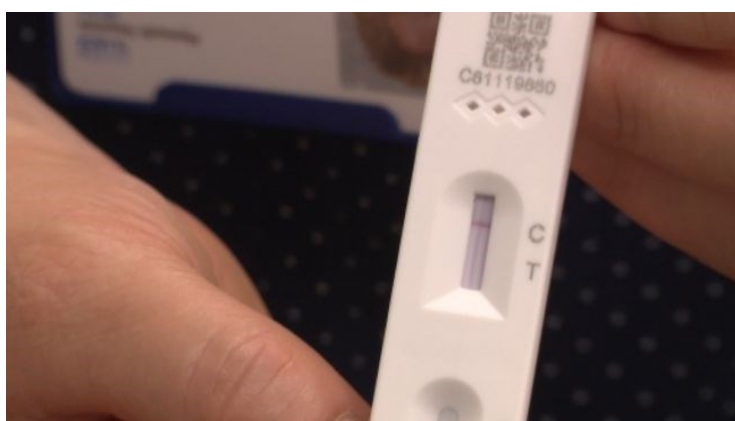
CLASS CHARTS REMINDER

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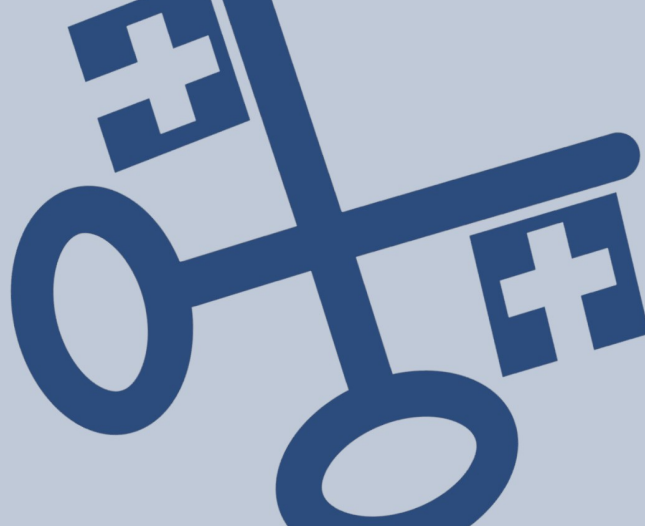
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GOVERNMENT LAPTOP LOANS

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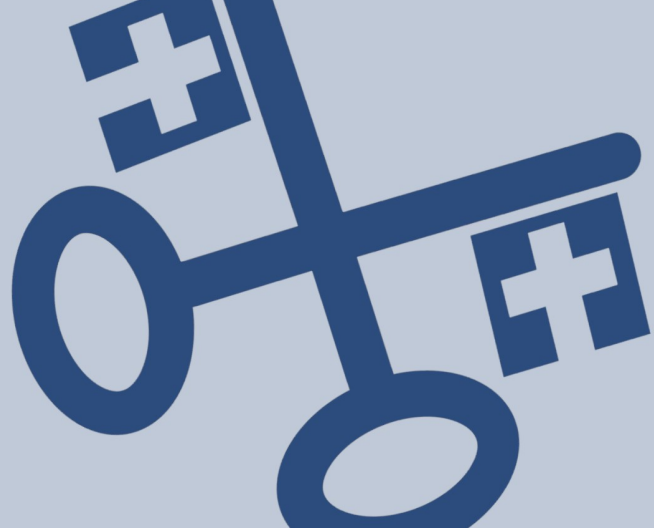
