Please ensure you have read the Admissions Criteria and Admission Arrangements carefully.

You <u>MUST</u> complete and return the Common Application Form [CAF] to your <u>Home</u> Local Authority <u>before 31st October 2021</u>.*

*Please note if you live outside Wolverhampton, you will need to check the closing date and send the completed CAF back to your Home LA before their. published deadline.

All applicants must name St Peter's Collegiate Academy as one of your preferences to be considered for a place.

In all cases, we will only look at the information on the form so please tell us all relevant information about the child, including any medical or pastoral needs.

Completing the Supporting Evidence Form

SECTION ONE – Please complete your child's details fully

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SECTION TWO - Please read the Admissions Criteria carefully and decide under which Category or Categories you can apply.

You can, of course, apply under more than one category.

Category A 'FOUNDATION PLACES' are for Church of England Families.

<u>Category B</u> **'CHRISTIAN fAITH PLACES'** are for Christian families, other than

Church of England. [e.g. Catholic, Baptist, Orthodox. Methodist]

For all Christian denominations a copy of your child's baptism certificate would be welcomed as supporting evidence under section 4.

<u>Category C</u> **'FAITH COMMUNITY PLACES'** are for other faith groups. [e.g. Sikh, Hindu, Muslim]

<u>Category D</u> 'PASTORAL PLACES' are offered to children of families/carers of any recognised faith community who must provide evidence on [e.g. Special Educational Needs or Looked After Children paperwork etc.] or with the Supporting Evidence Form, of the particular educational, social or medical needs which can be met especially well within the caring Christian environment of S.Peter's School.

Category E 'OPEN PLACES' allocated to families with any faith or none according to the oversubscription criteria [MOVE TO SECTION FIVE]

ALL APPLICANTS FOR CATEGORIES A TO D MUST MEET THE CRITERIA showing their commitment to a recognised faith.

N.B. If the Academy sees that it is obvious that you have selected the wrong category, they reserve the right to move the applications to the appropriate category.

Complete **SECTION THREE** indicating your family's current and/or previous place of worship, your frequency of attendance and involvement with your faith community – continue on a separate sheet if you need to.

Please ensure that you provide us with <u>all</u> the relevant information about your family. This could be in the form of a personal statement.

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Take your form to your faith leader for him/her to complete and sign **SECTION FOUR.** If your Faith Leader is not available, someone else from your place of worship, in authority, can sign the form on their behalf.

If a parent/carer happens to be the Faith Leader, then someone else with authority from the place of worship should complete the form on their behalf.

This should not be completed until the Family have completed Section 3

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The Parent/Carer must sign and date the form in **SECTION FIVE**

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RETURN THE SUPPORTING EVIDENCE FORM TO THE SCHOOL BY 12pm ON MONDAY 6th DECEMBER 2021
