Prayer Focus

Prayer areas during this second period of Ordinary Time are draped in green. At the start of the year emphasis can be placed upon the school Mission: what it means and the ways in which people hope to live out the Mission in their words and actions. During the Season of Creation (Sep 1-Oct 4), the prayer focus can include photos, images or items that reflect the wonders of creation including natural materials such as leaves, wheat etc. Images and icons of St. Francis of Assisi as well as his prayers and canticles could be included. Around Friday 6th October, Harvest Fast Day (CAFOD), when thanks is given to God for the harvest the prayer area focus can include donations of food and produce. This links with the Catholic Social Teaching principles of Stewardship of Creation and Option for the Poor and Vulnerable.

October, the Month of the Holy Rosary

Pictures of the Mysteries of the Rosary and Rosary beads can be placed upon the prayer focus as well as a statue, icon or images of Mary. The feast of St Therese of Lisieux falls on 1 October and Little Way Week begins on Monday 2 October. Prayer intentions for those in need as well as pledges of small acts of kindness could be included.

Little Way Week

Little Way Week commences on Monday September 25 2023 and culminates on Friday September 29. The feast of St Thérèse of Lisieux is on Sunday October 1.

St Thérèse lived in Lisieux, Normandy France and always wanted to follow Jesus and his loving example. When she was seven, she joined The Society of the Holy Childhood, which we now call Mission Together. Thérèse lived her life simply and is known as a 'missionary disciple'. This means in all her deeds and actions, she attempted to show the love of God to others. She said "Remember that nothing is small in the eyes of God. Do all that you do with love." This means no matter how old we are, we can make a difference to others.

During this week, schools are invited to participate in Mission Together, the Pope's charity for World Mission, to learn about St Thérèse and to demonstrate little acts of kindness to others. For example, give each child another class member's name. Encourage them to carry out a small act of kindness without the other person knowing who it was.
