Dear parents/carers,

Winter weather

As we enter into the winter months, I would like to remind you of the procedures for cold weather, in particular – snow. It is always our intention for the school to be open. We work hard to make the site accessible but we often have to put a number of restrictions in place in order to reduce risk. We attempt to clear paths and entrances and have the main access points gritted. This is sometimes challenged by the timing of the snowfall. This work starts very early in the morning to be ready for a usual start. However, there are times when we may need to make alternative arrangements. These may include:

- A delayed opening time
- School closure (before the day has begun)
- Early school closure (due to heavy snowfall during the day)
- Reduced parking on the carpark due to a lack of visibility of spaces and increased risk of skidding.

What we ask of you as parents:

- Please ensure that your child is suitably dressed in particular their footwear
- Be alert to messages sent about school closure. These would come via the text message service as well as being repeated on MarvellousMe. Please make sure that any relatives/child carers who are not on these systems are informed of the message if they are the person bringing your child to school.
- Should the school be closed this would also be reported via Wolverhampton Facebook
 Site by the Local Authority and the local radio.
- Please do not panic about punctuality. We recognise that the journey to school would be more challenging and safety is paramount. On occasions of snow, someone will remain at the back gate until 9:15am.

Whether or not we allow children to go outside on a snow day is risk assessed at the time and may differ per playground, as playgrounds get differing amounts of sunlight, melting ice – for example. We ask that you send suitable clothing in case this is a possibility.

As we move into what is the shortest term of the year, I would like to point out a few key events, share an updated calendar and inform you of the progress with the multi-academy St Gabriel the Archangel.
