Dear parents/carers,

I cannot believe that we have reached the final half term already! I am writing to remind you of a few important dates and also details of some of the forthcoming events.

We are looking forward to celebrating the **65th anniversary of the school** on **Monday 9th June**. On this day, Nursery will finish at 3:15pm along with the other children. We will dismiss pupils as usual and then invite you back in to the grounds if you are joining us. In the hall there will be a rolling photo display on the screen, showing some images and faces from the past and refreshments will be available (thank you to those who have shared these). Some of St Anthony's previous staff and pupils will be in the hall for a brief speech at 4pm.

All St Anthony's children will be able to claim a free icecream from the icecream van. Please come to the external door by the hall to collect your voucher.

There will be some activities to join in with on the field. Some will be free but the inflatables will cost £2 for 2 minutes. There will also be a craft stall available for purchases (usually featured at the summer fete), a 'Gigantic Easter Egg' raffle (held inside the hall) and a tombola (for church funds). The event will close at 5pm.

Sadly, there is no summer fete this year, so if you can support this event then we would love to see you!

On Wednesday 4th June we will be having a whole school photograph on the field, taken by a drone, in advance of the anniversary celebrations. We will be including all pupils in the photo as it will be fun to participate. It will be too distant to see any faces clearly, however, should you not wish for your child to be involved then please speak with Mrs Davis this Monday or Tuesday morning. Please pray for our Y6 pupils who are receiving **the Sacrament of Confirmation on Thursday 12th June at 6:30pm**, celebrated by Archbishop Bernard Longley. This is a holy and reverent occasion where the children take their next steps in their faith journey, making promises to continue their journey of faith into adulthood, beyond the initial gift of Baptism that their parents chose for them.

The Y6 Colour Run will take place on Thursday 17th July at 2pm. Parents are welcome to come and spectate this event. A letter will be sent regarding necessary clothing and goggles required as part of health and safety management. This is a fabulous opportunity to capture some great photographs. Pupils will be dismissed directly from the event so have some towels or sheets ready for the journey home!



Transition to the next year group: All pupils will be experiencing time in their new classrooms on the morning of Monday 30th June to Thursday 3rd July, whilst the Y6 pupils are visiting their secondary settings. Please be supportive of them as each year, some separate from their friends due to our 1.5 entry system. Please help them understand that class time is for learning and reassure them that they have time to see their friends during social time each and every day. Please do not suggest to them that some classes are better than others. Each year we have pupils making such comments and this does not come from school staff. Be assured that ALL pupils are taught their age-related curriculum. Our attainment outcomes demonstrate this. We do, however, have to group children who require more support where additional staff are available as there are not teaching assistants per classroom.

Any Y6 pupils who are on site during the transition week are to attend in PE/games kit as they will have a session each morning (Mon-Thurs) with Soccer 2000.





Finally, thank you to all for your amazing generosity in giving to the Lent Walk the Walk. You raised an **amazing £1133.85 which was split between Father Hudson's Caritas and CAFOD** (local and international impact). We have received thanks to share from both charities.
