**Assemblies with the PCSO:** Our local PCSO will be in school this half term, delivering assemblies and workshops to all of our children. Nursery and Reception will be focusing on 'People who help us', whilst KS1 children will talk about 'Keeping safe/strangers.' Pupils in LKS2 (Y3/4) will discuss 'Keeping safe online' whilst UKS2 (Y5/6) will focus on 'Anti-bullying, including







knife crime'. These sessions are all delivered in an age appropriate manner – please ask if you have any queries.

Each year we ask for contributions to the CAFOD World Gifts rather than children to spending money on Christmas Cards. This also supports our continued aims as a Live Simply school to protect the planet with reduced waste and production of short-term consumables as well as showing children that they can have an impact on the standards of living for their brothers and sisters across the world.
