Second in Charge for Mathematics – required for September 2022

Many thanks for your interest in the post of Second in Charge for Mathematics. I thought it may be helpful if I shared a few thoughts about the post and our school.

I feel blessed to be part of our school community, having been appointed Headteacher in September 2017. For the last four years, the school has been on a rapid journey towards outstanding. GCSE results continue to rise each year and in 2018-2019, our Progress 8 score of +0.29 placed us in the top 20% of schools in the country. Despite, the challenges of Covid-19, last year's results continued our upward trend with record numbers of students achieving straight Grades 7, 8 and 9s in every subject. These results are an important first step but the best is yet to come, we are confident that our future results will be even more impressive.

At St Oscar Romero's, our aim is simple, we want to be the best school in the country. This means that we can 'hand on heart' say that our students get a better deal than if they attended another school.

In March 2018, we were judged by Ofsted as 'Good' in all categories. This report is overwhelmingly positive about the journey the school has been on for the last three years and confirms the staff, governors, students and parents' absolute commitment to reach 'Outstanding' within one year. This was then confirmed in our Diocesan Section 48 Inspection in July 2019 which judged the school as 'Outstanding' in every category. This is a first for the school and a proud moment in the school's 60 year history. This is an exciting time for the school and our recent success is already breeding further success and aspiration.

The role of Second in Charge for Mathematics is fundamental to the school's vision and future success. The Mathematics Department are a talented and hardworking team of specialists who always go the extra mile for our students. We have exciting plans for Mathematics and passionately believe in having high expectations for all students within the subject. Our students love Mathematics and achieve well in the subject. We do, however, recognise there is a real opportunity for the successful candidate to build on the great work that is already being developed across the department.

The support and development of you as Second in Charge for Mathematics would be a priority for both the Subject Lead, alongside the SLT, helping you to flourish in your role, fulfil your potential and improve the life-chances of the children entrusted to our care. Whilst not imperative, I would suspect that the successful candidate will be someone aspiring to be Subject Lead within the next three years; something that I would be whole-heartedly committed to helping you achieve.
