I would like to extend our thanks to our established parents and families who have waited so patiently for this to happen and to all our new parents and families for joining us at this special time.

As you know, we plan to stay on a split temporary site, based at Heartlands and St Mary's for the duration of this year. This is whilst work is completed on our new site, which, is scheduled to be completed around August 2019. Work on site is due to start on 9th September. I will keep you updated about progress and development through the year.



COMMUNICATION: We want all parents, carers and families to feel valued and supported and we will endeavour to keep communication

channels as open as possible. Previous questionnaires to families has told us that communication via newsletters and letters is not always the most effective. Therefore we will be looking to launching a school app called *MyChildAtSchool* which can be used to send information about school and your child's progress straight to your smartphone.

Home/School Diaries Each pupil will have a home/school diary. This is for two way communication between home and school. Staff will write in them each day to give you an outline of your child's day at school. We ask you to comment or use the book too in order to let us know of anything significant that would 9be important for us to know. It is really useful for us to know things such as your child missed breakfast, your child didn't sleep well the night before, there has been changes in family circumstances and so on. Each little thing has such a significant impact on your child that it is good for us to know. If you feel that information is too sensitive to write in the diary, please just give us a ring or email us.
