

| Someone who sells flowers and plants to customers. Florists also make floral arrangements for weddings, funerals and other events. |
| Florists mostly work in there own shops or have stalls in markets and train stations. Some florists now operate online. |
| You will need to be creative and know how to care for plants. You will need to have good customer service skills and time keeping, to make sure orders go out on time. |
| Most florists work Monday to Saturday for about 8 to 10 hours per day. Florists can start very early in the morning. |

| Florists are typically paid a starting wage of £12,500 per year. This increases with experience. Skilled florists can expect to earn approximately £20,000 per year. |
