Job name	Postal / Delivery Worker
What is it?	As a Postman/woman you will be expected to: Sort the parcels and letters for your route, deliver the mail to homes and business, re-direct wrongly-addressed mail, collect signatures for recorded mail.
Where do you do it?	Royal mail is the most well known company. However over the last few years companies like Amazon, DHL, EVIR and DPD, also offer delivery services for people buying items online.
Skills you need.....	A good level of fitness and a polite manner. You will also need to be trustworthy and able to read the addresses and road names. You may be required to drive, in which case you will need a driving license.
What days / hours do you work?	Around 41-43 hours per week. It is likely that you will start work very early in the morning and be very busy during holidays like Christmas.
