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## MESSAGE FROM HEADTEACHER:



Hi everyone,

Here we are in the last week of the half term. I just wanted to bring to your attention a couple of things. We have noticed a slip in the correct uniform being worn to school. Can I remind you that this is expected for all pupils. For those pupils who have a sensory difficulty with clothing, there will be an arrangement, but we do request that pupils wearing their own clothes follow the colours of the school uniform. Black bottoms, white shirts and navy tops. Please can we ask for your support with this as it is difficult for some pupils to understand why the rule is not applied consistently.
