

Trinity Catholic High School GCSE Results 2023

GCSE attainment at Trinity remains **outstanding** and **significantly** above national statistics with the school once again securing very high standards at KS4. In 2023 key headline measure results are broadly in line with 2019. Nationally GCSE results have returned to pre-pandemic levels, similar to those in 2019. Students at Trinity can be very proud of their achievements. Some of the most significant achievements are as follows:

Summary of Key Headlines

Attainment 8: The Attainment 8 score, which measures a student's average grade across eight subjects, is **56.90**.

EBacc: The EBacc average point score is **4.87**.

Strong Pass in English and Mathematics: The percentage of students achieving at least grade 5+ in both English and mathematics remains outstanding at **66%**.

Standard Pass in English and Mathematics: The percentage of students achieving at least grade 4+ in both English and mathematics remains outstanding at **86%**.

Standard Pass: The percentage of students achieving 5 or more 9-4 (standard pass) GCSEs remains outstanding at **83**%.

Top Grades: Achievement at the top end is excellent. The percentage of students achieving 5 or more top grades at 9-7 remains outstanding at **29%**. 7% of all entries were grade 9 and 33% of all entries were grades 9-7.

Overall subject achievement is excellent at 9-4 (standard pass) and 9-5 (strong pass). Of the 24 GCSE subjects, 18 achieved 80%+ 9-4 and 16 achieved 70%+ 9-5. Subject achievement is in most cases significantly above national values.

GCSE attainment in English and mathematics is excellent, building on historically strong attainment. 36% of students were awarded the higher grades of 9-7 in English (the best of English Language and English Literature). 26% of students were awarded the higher grades of 9-7 in English Language. 28% of students were awarded the higher grades of 9-7 in English Literature. This is above the provisional 16-year-old national data (England Only) for English Language at 16% 9-7 and English Literature 21% 9-7. 31% of students were awarded the higher grades of 9-7 in mathematics. This is above the provisional 16-year-old national data (England Only) for mathematics at 17% 9-7. 73% of students attained 9-5 in English Language. 73% of students attained 9-5 in English Literature. 73% of students achieved 9-5 in mathematics. 90% of students attained 9-4 in English Language and 90% of students attained 9-4 in English Literature. This is above the provisional 16-year-old national data (England Only) for English Language at 64% grade 4 or higher and 74% grade 4 or higher in English Literature. 89% of students attained 9-4 in mathematics. This is significantly above the provisional 16-year-olds national data (England Only) for mathematics at 61% grade 4 or higher.
