## Trinity Catholic High School A Level Results 2023

Trinity students have again achieved excellent results with an A Level pass rate of $98 \%$ which is above the average for Redbridge state funded schools. Ofqual advises comparing the 2023 results with those from 2019, the last year that summer exams were taken before the pandemic, as grade boundaries returned to those levels. Our results show an increase across key measures.

Some of the most significant achievements are as follows:

## Summary of Key Headlines

Around $\mathbf{2 0 \%}$ of all students were awarded $\mathbf{A}^{*}$-A grades, an increase of $2 \%$ on 2019 results.
Over 43\% of all students were awarded $\mathbf{A}^{*}$-B grades, an increase of 4\% on 2019 results.
Around 72\% of students achieved A*-C, a 7\% increase on 2019 results.
20 students achieved $A^{\star} / A$ across all subjects.

## Key measures

Average Point Score (per A Level entry): is 32.71 (2019: 31)
Average Point Score (expressed as a grade): is C+ (2019: C).
Percentage of students achieving at least AAB in at least 2 facilitating subjects: is $\mathbf{1 1 \%}$ (2019: 9\%).
Percentage of students achieving at least $\mathbf{3}$ A Levels A*-E: is consistent with 2019 at $\mathbf{8 3 \%}$.

## Subject specific information

The pass rate for 16 of our A Level subjects was $100 \%$. There were 118 A* and A grades awarded to our students. 4 students achieved grades $A^{*} / A$ in 4 subjects.

At $A^{*} / A$ grades the following subjects exceeded the UK national figures: Art $40 \% A^{*} / A$ (National: 31\%), Biology 36\% A*/A (National: 26\%), Chemistry 36\% A*/A (National: 31\%), Computing 23\% A $/$ /A (National: 22\%), Music 50\% A*/A (National: 23\%), Physics 35\% A*/A (National: 31\%), Spanish 50\% A*/A (National: 35\%), PE 20\% A*/A (National: 17\%).

At A ${ }^{*} / \mathrm{C}$ grades the following subjects exceeded the UK national figures: Art 100\% A*/C (National: 85\%), Biology $90 \%$ A $/$ C (National: $67 \%$ ), Chemistry $82 \%$ A $/$ /C (National: $71 \%$ ), Computing $81 \%$ A $/$ C (National: 75\%), Drama 100\% A*/C (National: 83\%), English Combined 83\% A*/C (National: 79\%), Geography 82\% A*/C (National: 79\%), History 85\% A*/C (National: 80\%), Music 100\% A*/C (National: 75\%), Physics 73\% A*/C (National: 69\%), Philosophy and Ethics 82\% A*/C (National: 79\%).

The pass rate for other Level 3 qualifications in Core Maths, Food Science and the Extended Project Qualification was $100 \%$.

## Progression to University

Over 180 students applied for places at UK universities. The process was as always, competitive, yet $74 \%$ successfully gained places at their first choice of university with others being placed with their insurance choices.
