

16 to 19 Tuition Funding

We have 9 students in Year 12 who have not achieved a grade 4 in Maths and/or English. These students will have an additional one period added to their timetable compared to students in a similar situation in 2020 – 2021. They will be taught as a small group of no more than 5 in each of Maths and English. This will run for the academic year 2021 – 2022 through to the end of May. This will be taught by existing members of staff and equates to 32 teaching periods in each subject and costed as a fulltime member of staff for four weeks. £3460

We have 3 students in Year 13 who have not achieved a grade 4 in Maths. These students will have additional small group tuition added to their timetable. This will run for the academic year 2021 – 2022 through to the start of May. A member of staff will need to be recruited for this. It is intended that tuition is 2hrs a week for 28 weeks at a rate of £29 per hour = £1624

All disadvantaged students in Year 12 and Y13 will attend 2 'Elevate Education' study skills sessions. These will support with developing independent learning through time management and a session on exam preparation at a total cost of £750.

Friday 17 September afternoon Year 12 'Time management'

Friday 6th or 13th May Year 12 'Ace your exams'

Monday 28th March Year 13 'The Finishing Line'

£250 times 3 = £750.

All disadvantaged students in Year 13 will attend 1 'Elevate Education' study skills sessions during Year 13 in support of exam preparation.

This will be as a group of 14 students.

We have 14 disadvantaged students in Year 13 who have failed to meet their target grade in one or more of their A level subjects as assessed by their end of year 12 examinations. Intervention sessions will take place for these students across 14 subject areas for two 4 week period prior to the November and March assessments. These sessions will be staffed by Trinity teachers at a total cost for an 8 week programme £4640.
