Dear Parents and Carers of St Antony's Catholic Primary School,

I am writing as Headteacher of Trinity Catholic High School to inform you about two recent incidents involving Trinity students.

An incident occurred after school on Friday and a further incident involving the same students took place after school yesterday. Both incidents happened on Mornington Road near St Antony's.

I have reviewed the video evidence and the scenes are distressing. I am disappointed that the students involved failed to resolve their differences despite clear intervention, guidance, and support from the school.

This behaviour falls well below the standards expected of Trinity students. Those involved have let themselves, their families, and the wider community down.

I am sorry that some members of your community witnessed these incidents. Please be reassured we are taking this matter seriously and firm, decisive action is being taken in line with our behaviour policy.

The parents of the students involved have been contacted. They have been supportive and cooperative and a full investigation is underway. Once all evidence is gathered, the school will make an informed decision and apply appropriate actions and support.

We expect our students to show respect, self-control, and responsibility at all times, including after school and within the local community. We value our close relationship with St Antony's and remain committed to working together to uphold shared expectations.
