### Heritage Language Exams

Examinations in Heritage Languages assess 4 main areas:

- Speaking
- Reading
- ▶ Writing
- Listening

Assessments are not like the usual curriculum / courses of study and are targeted at students whose first / home language is not English.

#### Heritage Language Exams

- Examinations can be taken at any time during Y9, Y10 or Y11
- Students must prepare for the assessments independently
- Family can organise support to prepare for the content
- ▶ Trinity does not put timetabled lessons in place
- ▶ We will pay for the exam entries
- ▶ We will facilitate and arrange the assessments
- We will arrange the assessors for each language

- ▶ Gain an additional GCSE, give yourself the edge over others
- ▶ Home Languages are to be celebrated
- An exam can be used to set your child a target to reach a particular level of proficiency
