1	Watch the news, use the BBC app or BBC.co.uk
2	Use Social Media for articles posted by teachers around the country (e.g. tutor2u facebook page)
3	Take time to review your class notes every evening so that you can synthesize everything you have absorbed.
4	Complete past exam paper questions to improve your knowledge.
5	Spend time out of lesson discussing with peers' topics discussed in lesson. A study group is also helpful.
6	Spend 20 minutes a week filing notes properly.
7	Time yourself on past exam papers and questions for homework. Before starting factor in time to reread your answer at the end.
8	Any word that was used in lesson that students don't understand should be put in a glossary they create.
9	Set goals for yourself. Write them down. List everything that you want to accomplish! Set Deadlines! Once you have the end in mind, you can achieve your desired outcome. A series of small goals leading up to the completion of a large goal keeps tasks from becoming insurmountable.
10	Engage in conversation with peers/family/friends about relatable topics being discussed in lessons.
