| Number | Proactive Independent Study Checklist |
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| 1 | Watch the news, use the BBC app or BBC.co.uk |
| 2 | Use Social Media for articles posted by teachers around the country (e.g. tutor2u facebook page) |
| 3 | Take time to review your class notes every evening so that you can synthesize everything you have absorbed. |
| 4 | Complete past exam paper questions to improve your knowledge. |
| 5 | Spend time out of lesson discussing with peers' topics discussed in lesson. A study group is also helpful. |
| 6 | Spend 20 minutes a week filing notes properly. |
| 7 | Time yourself on past exam papers and questions for homework. Before starting factor in time to reread your answer at the end. |
| 8 | Any word that was used in lesson that students don't understand should be put in a glossary they create. |
| 9 | Set goals for yourself. Write them down. List everything that you want to accomplish! Set Deadlines! Once you have the end in mind, you can achieve your desired outcome. A series of small goals leading up to the completion of a large goal keeps tasks from becoming insurmountable. |
| 10 | Engage in conversation with peers/family/friends about relatable topics being discussed in lessons. |
