Activity	Benefits of the task
<p>1. Watching Massolit lectures. You can make notes on the website or on paper. Some lectures also have a follow-up quiz to test your knowledge.</p>	<p>Massolit is an online platform where you can watch lectures from university professors. This can deepen your knowledge and understanding of psychology. It is like having a second teacher! Often the university professors will go beyond the A-level curriculum.</p>
<p>2. Going on to AQA A-level Psychology page. Download and complete a past paper. Download the mark scheme and self-assess.</p>	<p>Practising a full paper for example under timed conditions will give you the time management skills that are essential in your actual exam. Looking at how questions are worded will consolidate your understanding on what the examiner is asking you. Self-assessing using the mark-scheme will help you understand how the examiners will assess you and how marks are distributed. Exemplar answers and feedback from examiners help with developing examination skills and also the expectation required in answers.</p>
<p>3. Using Kerboodle</p>	<p>Kerboodle is an online platform of the A-level Psychology textbook it is full of interactive activities such as quizzes, revision cards etc. You can also download exam questions and complete worksheets. This is a good example of a revision activity.</p>
<p>4. Use of Seneca</p>	<p>Seneca is an online platform where your teacher can assign you a course to complete. The course is interactive with interactive activities. Your teacher will give you access to the course at the start of your unit. This means you can complete the course in your own pace, as a pre-reading activity or as a revision activity.</p>
<p>5. Use of psychology library in room 43 and 46</p>	<p>At the back of our classrooms, we have a rich library of psychology review articles, textbooks, and workbooks for students. You will also see model folders from past A-level psychology students. Doing further reading will impress your teacher and the examiner as you will have knowledge of more up-to-date studies and you will have more evidence to draw from in your evaluation.</p>
