Re: Drew Rogers – Languages / Entrepreneurship masterclass

I am writing in regard to a masterclass to be delivered on Friday 24 February 3.30pm – 4.30pm for all interested students in St Joseph's common room. This masterclass will be delivered by Drew Rogers, and is part of our continued suite of masterclass opportunities for language students, but also our students interested in business, entrepreneurship and the tech, digital marketing and social media sectors.

Drew is the Founder of My Language Lab and has tutored hundreds of students from adults to exam students and SMEs. Her portfolio of corporate clients includes, Amazon Prime, Disney, the BBC, the NHS, HBO, Admiral Plc, The Economist, Foreign & Commonwealth Office, Premiership Football Clubs and Pinewood TV Studios.

Drew was born in Tanzania and moved to London speaking little English and speaks 5 languages. Drew studied European Studies with Spanish, French and Italian at Cardiff University. Following graduation Drew worked as a Financial and Business Analyst for Citigroup and Thomson Reuters in the City, liaising with European banks. Returning to her love of languages, she launched her first academy in Cardiff before later opening in Bristol and London. Drew is fluent in English, Spanish, French, Gujarati and conversational Italian. Drew was also selected in the UK's 100 most inspiring female entrepreneurs in Small Business Britain's 2022 awards.

This masterclass will include an opportunity for students to ask questions and is open to all students interested, but is especially important for students considering their options in Year 9; students currently studying languages at KS4 and KS5 and indeed our business and media students. We hope that this will be a rewarding experience and a chance for students to ask some insightful questions.
