

## Trinity Catholic High School GCSE Results 2024

Across the country, grading proceeded as usual this summer, building on the return to pre-pandemic standards established last year. At Trinity, GCSE attainment continues to be exceptional, consistently surpassing national averages. This year, the school has not only maintained its high standards at KS4 but, in many cases, has seen improvements in key thresholds compared to historical outcomes. Trinity students can take immense pride in their accomplishments. Among the most notable achievements are:

### Summary of Key Headlines

**Attainment 8:** The Attainment 8 score, which measures a student's average grade across eight subjects, is **56.35**.

**EBacc:** The EBacc average point score is **4.91**.

**Strong Pass in English and Mathematics:** The percentage of students achieving at least grade 5+ in both English and mathematics remains outstanding at **67%**.

**Standard Pass in English and Mathematics:** The percentage of students achieving at least grade 4+ in both English and mathematics remains outstanding at **90%**.

**Standard Pass:** The percentage of students achieving 5 or more 9-4 (standard pass) GCSEs remains outstanding at **83%**.

**Top Grades:** Achievement at the top end is excellent. The percentage of students achieving 5 or more top grades at 9-7 remains outstanding at **25%**. **31%** of all entries were grades 9-7.

**Overall subject achievement is excellent at 9-4 (standard pass) and 9-5 (strong pass).** Of the 24 GCSE subjects, 17 achieved 80%+ 9-4 and 15 achieved 70%+ 9-5. Subject achievement is in most cases significantly above national values.

**GCSE attainment in English and mathematics is outstanding, building on historically strong attainment.** 41% of students were awarded the higher grades of 9-7 in English (the best of English Language and English Literature). 33% of students were awarded the higher grades of 9-7 in English Language. 29% of students were awarded the higher grades of 9-7 in English Literature. This is above the provisional national data (England Only) for English Language at 16% 9-7 and English Literature 21% 9-7. 29% of students were awarded the higher grades of 9-7 in mathematics. This is above the provisional national data (England Only) for mathematics at 17% 9-7. 75% of students attained 9-5 in English Language. 75% of students attained 9-5 in English Literature. 75% of students achieved 9-5 in mathematics. 90% of students attained 9-4 in English Language and 89% of students attained 9-4 in English Literature. This is above the national data (England Only) for English Language at 62% grade 4 or higher and 74% grade 4 or higher in English Literature. 93% of students attained 9-4 in mathematics. This is significantly above the provisional national data (England Only) for mathematics at 60% grade 4 or higher.
