

GIFT AID DECLARATION FORM

Gift Aid can be a simple and effective way to boost funding for our school. Gift Aid is a tax relief which allows a charity, such as Trinity, to reclaim from HMRC the basic rate of Income Tax a donor has paid on their donation (gift). Gift Aid is reclaimed by Trinity from the tax you pay for the current tax year. Your address is needed to identify you as a current UK taxpayer.
