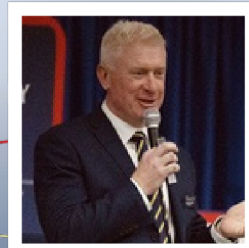

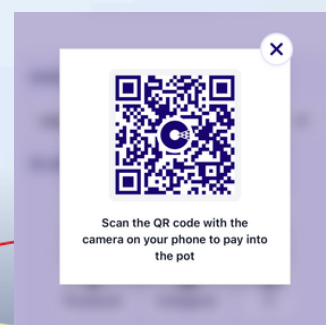

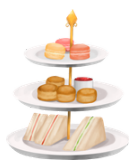

Her achievement highlights the importance of staying active, setting personal goals, and looking after both physical and mental wellbeing.

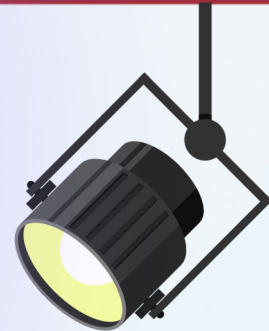

## Luminaries Programme

This week, Ms Duffy met with students in the Luminaries Programme to discuss Finding Your



academic Voice and Understanding Oxbridge. The session provided insight into the Oxbridge application process and encouraged students to explore their academic interests more deeply. The programme offers specialist support through enrichment opportunities, admissions preparation and interview coaching for students aiming for highly competitive universities.

## Maths Admission Test Webinar

The Oxford Mathematics department is running a weekly livestream with maths problems and problem-solving strategies, with a focus on the Test of Mathematics for University Admission (TMUA) and mathematics interviews. The sessions are free and available for everyone, and are recorded so that you can watch them later even if you can't join us live.

Year 12 students will soon begin their End of Year mock examinations, which form an important part of the evidence used to determine predicted grades for university, apprenticeship and other post-18 applications.

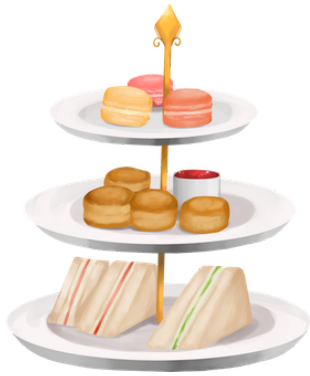
