Activities to try at home

Number Bond Bingo

Make a simple bingo grid with numbers between 1 and 99.
Call out a number, e.g. 37. Your child has to find or work out its number bond to 100: 63.

Counting in 25s Around the House

Write numbers in the sequence:
25, 50, 75, 100, 125, 150, 175, 200...

Place them around the house.

Your child has to follow the sequence, touching each number as they count.

Roll and Add 1,000

Roll a dice to generate a starting number, e.g. 4 would be **4,000**.
Keep adding 1,000:
