

How to Wear the School Uniform

ALL PUPILS	DETAILS	HOW TO WEAR THE SCHOOL UNIFORM
Shirt	Plain white traditional school shirt with collar. Shirt sleeves may be long or short	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students ensure that collar button is fastened at all times Students not to wear coloured vests beneath shirts No fashion shirts/blouses Tuck shirt into trousers/skirt If shirt cannot be tucked into trousers/skirt it is deemed inappropriate for school
Tie	School tie	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Tie should meet neatly with shirt collar Tie knot should be single or Double Windsor Tie must show school badge just below knot Tie must show at least four stripes Tie must not be tucked into shirt
Blazer	School black blazer with embroidered school badge	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Blazer must be worn when travelling to and from school and when transiting between lessons Removal of blazers during the lesson is at the discretion of the teacher Sleeves must be worn at full length (not pushed back)
Trousers	Plain black, tailored straight-legged school trousers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Approved black school trousers from designated supplier
Skirt	School skirt purchased from designated supplier	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Approved style only Skirt length should be knee-length.
Sweater (optional)	School sweater with embroidered school emblem	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Not to be tied around the waist when not being worn
Cardigan (optional)	These bear the school emblem and are only available from school	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No other cardigans are permissible

Tights	Plain black	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Opaque No pattern
Shoes	Black low heel only Plain black, sensible school shoes Must not be two-toned or striped	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Heels of 3.5cm maximum No trainers or trainer-style shoes For safety reasons, ballet-type shoes, no flip-flops, sandals, plimsolls, backless, slip-on shoes or 'Uggs' No fashion statements
Outer clothing	Dark coat or jacket, preferably waterproof	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No hooded tops, sweatshirts, or tracksuit tops No denim, leather or leather-look garments
School bag	Minimum size to hold at least an A4-sized folder	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Suitable schoolbag, not a handbag No fashion bags
Make up	Make up should not be worn in school, including false tan	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Make up should not be brought into school No nail varnish No false nails
Jewellery	No jewellery (In consultation with heads of year, students who are required to carry emergency medical information at all times are exempt.)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pupils must not wear jewellery to school No earrings/bracelets/rings or hair adornments No face, tongue or other piercings
Haircuts	Smart appearance No extreme two-tone colours Natural hair colours only Eyebrows must not be shaved	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No extremes of fashion eg Mohican style, no 'v' shape style, rats tails etc No 'tramlines' or shapes shaved into hair 'Number 2' haircut is the minimum length allowed No outlandish colours; natural colours only
