What will the exams look like?

- Exam Board AQA GCSE each exam 1h30.
- Foundation tier grade 1-5.
- · Higher tier grade 3 9.
- Students tested on all topics from their five year maths curriculum.
 This covers the following strands; algebra, geometry, number, ratio, probability, data and statistics.
- Questions are a mixture of fluency, problem solving and reasoning.




How to support at home?

- Help your child to prioritise your child should be spending at least 90 minutes on their homework / revision each week. (orange homework book)
- Homework IS revision.
- Little and often. Often the work is easy to split into 30 min chunks.
- Equipment.
- Revision guides / corbett maths flashcards / formula sheets test your child.
- Encourage your child to do fix up 5's / MemRi on Hegarty maths.
- If your child gets stuck with homework, encourage them to watch the Hegarty maths revision video to support in the first instance.
