Sixth Form Dress Code 2020-21

Males:

Black, Navy, Grey trousers not jeans (including no skinny jeans)

Collared shirt and tie

Plain black/brown/ Navy formal shoes (No 'pump' style shoes such as; Vans/ Converse)

Lanyards must be worn to ensure the safeguarding of all students.

Females:

Black, Navy, Grey trousers/ skirt (no miniskirts) not jeans (including no skinny jeans)

Blouse or shirt (covering shoulders, back and midriff)

Plain black/brown/ Navy formal shoes (No 'pump' style shoes such as; Vans/ Converse)

Lanyards must be worn to ensure the safeguarding of all students.

Trainers will only be allowed for PE lessons

Sportswear

BTEC Sport, A-Level PE, CSLA/HSLA students are permitted to wear Whickham Sport kit (Whickham top, appropriate black bottoms and hooded top) **on days they have practical lessons only**. If you do not have Whickham Sixth Form PE kit you need to get changed for practical lessons.

Recreational Sport students are required to change from their SF Dress code to sportswear for practical sessions. They need to register with the allocated member of staff and then get changed. Students are not permitted to wear their sportswear for the full school day. Sweat style joggers are not permitted. Students must wear suitable trainers for sporting lessons not 'pump' style shoes.

Students not adhering to the dress code will be sent home in order to get changed into appropriate clothing.

***Please note mobile phones are not permitted to be out in tutorial or lesson time. Students found with mobile phones will be asked to put these away and repeated incidents may result in the phone being confiscated.**
