

## How will school work if the site is closed? Our plans for remote learning in 2020/21



Work will be set on Google Classroom which is accessible from the school website once you log in.

- We will ensure new pupils are set familiarisation tasks on Google Classroom at the start of the year.



We will aim to set the same amount of work as you would usually have in your timetabled lessons. To give pupils flexibility we will set work on a weekly basis as much as possible. You will need to pay attention to submission deadlines (as you would do with homework).



Work will be submitted on Google Classroom. Some work will be self assessed, some work will receive group feedback from teachers and some work will receive individualised feedback from teachers. If you are stuck on work or finding things difficult you should email your teacher.



We will continue to use ClassCharts to award points and for live reporting. We will not be setting homework in addition to your remote learning tasks on Google Classroom.
