

Games testers get paid to play computer games, to check they work, identify and record problems, glitches or bugs and to suggest improvements. They can often be required to play the same part of the game repeatedly for long periods of time, either alone or in a team. They check games for accessibility, copyright infringement and quality assure instructions, manuals and packaging
