

Writing an Essay

Make a Plan

- Read the question and make sure you understand exactly what is being asked
- Detail how you are going to breakdown your main points
- List any additional sources of material you will need to back up your points

Introduction

- Start with a clear introduction that relates closely to the topic of the essay
- Give a clear concise summary of what your essay will be about and what can be expected from the content in the body in order of importance
- Avoid going into too much detail

The Main Body

- Present your points in the same order as your introduction
- Explain and develop your arguments and provide detailed analysis to support your points accurately and appropriately

Conclusion

- Bring your essay to a logical end with a summary and evaluation of the arguments described throughout the body of your essay.
- Reference key points and arguments before arriving back at how these answer the original question posed by your essay title.

Bibliography

- Include a bibliography. This is a list of any sources or texts you have used to help you write your essay
