

How to Wear the School Uniform

ALL PUPILS	DETAILS	HOW TO WEAR THE SCHOOL UNIFORM
Shirt	Plain white traditional school shirt with collar. Shirt sleeves may be long or short	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students ensure that collar button is fastened at all times Students not to wear coloured vests beneath shirts No fashion shirts/blouses Tuck shirt into trousers/skirt If shirt cannot be tucked into trousers/skirt it is deemed inappropriate for school
Tie	School tie	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Clip-on school tie
Blazer	School blazer with embroidered school badge	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Blazer must be worn when travelling to and from school and when transitioning between lessons Removal of blazers during the lesson is at the discretion of the teacher Sleeves must be worn at full length (not pushed back)
Trousers	Plain black, tailored straight legged school trousers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Approved black school trousers from designated supplier Not skin tight or elastic material
Skirt	School skirt purchased from designated supplier	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Approved style only Skirt length should be knee length, pleated skirt.
Tights	Plain black	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Opaque

		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No pattern
Shoes	Black low heel only Plain black, sensible school shoes Must not be two toned or striped	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Heels of 3.5cm maximum No trainers or trainers style shoes including Vans, converse For safety reasons, no ballet-type shoes, flip-flops, sandals, plimsolls, backless, slip on shoes or 'Uggs' No fashion statements- this includes 'Vivienne Westwood' slip on shoes.
Outer clothing	Sensible plain coat or jacket, preferably waterproof and reflective for darker evenings	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No hooded tops, sweatshirts, or tracksuit tops No denim, large logos, leather or leather-look garments
School bag	Minimum size to hold at least an A4-sized folder	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Suitable school bag, not a handbag
Make up	Make up should not be worn in school, including false tan	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Make up should not be brought into school No nail varnish No false nails or false eyelashes
Jewellery	No jewellery (In consultation with heads of year, students who are required to carry emergency medical information at all times are exempt.)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pupils must not wear jewellery to school No earrings/bracelets/rings or hair adornments No face, tongue, nose or other piercings
Haircuts	Smart appearance No extreme two-tone colours Natural hair colours only Eyebrows must not be shaved	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No extremes of fashion eg Mohican style, no 'v' shape style, rats tails etc No 'tramlines' or shapes shaved into hair 'Number 2' haircut is the minimum length allowed No outlandish colours; natural colours only
Socks	Black Socks	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Black socks, not to be worn over tights
