Dear Parent / Carer

I am delighted to welcome you and your child to Whickham School. The transition process is an important one and we want to ensure you have all of the information you need and that we support your child in looking forward to joining us.

There are several things that you will need to do over the coming weeks and months and we have put together a range of information to support you.

### **School uniform and PE kit**

All pupils are required to be in full uniform each day. You can find our uniform expectations by visiting the school website <https://www.whickhamschool.org/parents-information/uniform/>. Our supplier, Michael Sehgal's, will be holding a pop up shop event at Whickham School on Saturday 29 June in our main hall to purchase uniform and PE kit. School uniform orders can be placed at [www.michaelsehgal.co.uk](http://www.michaelsehgal.co.uk) and their advice is to order early, as supply shortages mean that replenishment may take longer. Only orders that are placed by 31st July can be guaranteed to be fulfilled in time for the new term. Free delivery is available on orders above £40.

### **Student starter packs**

The starter pack contains an equipment pack, tie, apron (for Design and Technology lessons), scientific calculator and sketchbook. The cost of the pack is £23. Payments can be made on-line via the school's [ParentPay Shop](#) which can be found on the school website, 'parents' 'information' 'on-line shop'. Please ensure that you select September 2024 when ordering your starter kit. The starter packs can be collected on Saturday 29 June in the main hall when you purchase your uniforms and PE kit.

Please note school planners will no longer be included in packs as students are choosing to organise themselves via Classcharts. If your child would prefer to use a traditional planner, they are welcome

to do so in school however will be expected to purchase one separately as we no longer have these available.
