Terminology

- Phonemes The sounds we hear
- Graphemes The letters we see written down
- Diagraph 2 letters that work together to make one sound
- Trigraph 3 letters that work together to make one sound
- Split diagraph A vowel and a letter 'e' that are split by a consonant e.g.
 shake
- Blending putting together the individual sounds to make a word
- Segmenting Breaking a word down into its individual sounds

How to say the sounds

What do Read Write Inc lessons look like at Wigmore Primary School?

- Lessons take place daily from 9:00-9:40am
- Children are grouped based on their phonics knowledge and need, not their age.
- Children are assessed by the Phonics leader before every half term and then regrouped accordingly.
- Children's progress is monitored and 1:1 tuition is used in school to support children who need extra help to progress.
- Phonics lessons consist of a 'speed sound' lesson followed by reading activities and a story matched to their phonics learning.
- Children take home a book matched to their phonics group








What will the children read?

Phonics Screening Check 2023 – Key Information

- National test sat by all children in Year 1
- This year schools will take the test sometime during the week beginning Monday 12th
 June
- Pass mark is usually 32/40
- Children who do not reach this pass mark will resit the check again in Year 2
- Your child will sit with a teacher 1:1 and complete the test
- Usually the test takes around 10 minutes
- We will inform you of your child's result and if they have passed following the test
- If your child does not reach the pass mark they will retake the screening test in Year 2

How can you support your child?

- READ READ!
- The most important thing you can do is read regularly with your child.
- Please spend 10 minutes every night reading with your child and then comment and sign their yellow reading record book
- If your child is struggling with a word encourage them to use FRED TALK...
 in other words reading the individual sounds then blending.
- Watch out for teachers sending home video links to the RWI virtual classroom – Starting after half term.
- These will be sent home weekly using google classroom
- These are short 5 10 minute videos the children can join in with
- Play Fred games Fred I spy/Fred's fridge/Fred's wardrobe
