We are looking forward to seeing you and we hope you enjoy the show!

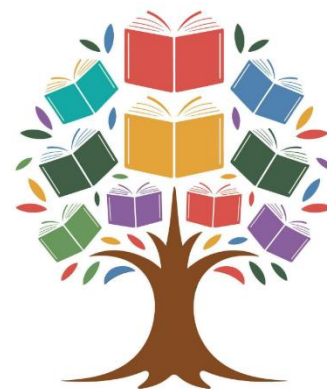
## Become a Secret Reader!
