Smart Watches and Jewellery Reminder

We would like to remind parents that smart watches should not be worn in school. A smart watch is a digital watch that can do much more than tell the time. Many smart watches can connect to the internet (such as Wi-Fi or mobile networks) and may have features similar to a mobile phone, including messaging, phone calls, taking photographs, recording video or audio, tracking location, and accessing apps or games.

We also remind parents that, for health and safety reasons, earrings should not be worn in school. The only exception is small stud earrings, which may be worn for up to six weeks following ear piercing to allow time for healing.
