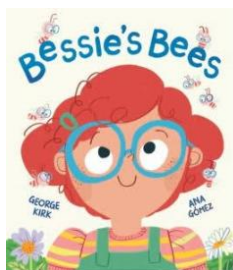
PTA Summer Fair

George Kirk Author Visit



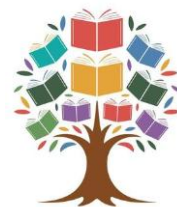
Reception and Year 1 children were delighted to welcome a special visitor to school this week, when author George Kirk came to share her stories and inspire our young readers.

Pick-Up Arrangements for Years 2, 3 and 4

As our school continues to grow, with more children using the upstairs classrooms and exiting through the doors at the bottom of the stairs, we are looking at ways to reduce congestion at the end of the school day and make collection arrangements smoother and safer for everyone.

From September, the pick-up arrangements will be:

- **Year 2 and Year 3** will continue to be collected from the doors at the bottom of the stairs;
- **Year 4** will be dismissed from the hall door.

To help us prepare for September, we will be trialling our new pick-up arrangements next week. This will give us an opportunity to see how the system works and make any necessary adjustments before the start of the new term. The current Year 3 class will be dismissed from the hall door.

We appreciate your support and patience as we trial these arrangements and work to ensure a safe and efficient end to the school day for all our children.
